

Message To The Members From Theresa (Terry) Hebior, Exalted Ruler

It's hard to believe that only 1 year ago I was cruising with family and friends when COVID-19 extended our vacation and introduced us to Federal Quarantine. So much has changed over the last 12 months it's impossible to grasp but as I reflect upon this year, I realize that no Pandemic is going to keep our lodge from thriving. Here is a brief year in review. Our lodge grew in membership! We exceeded our financial requirements to the Elks National Foundation and to Harry Anna Charities. The Brotherhood Ride returned to our lodge and we provided the bicycle riders and support team with showers, meals and a place to sleep. They provided us with tributes of fallen hero's and inspired us with their mission. We applied for three ENF grants and received over \$8000 dollars in grant money. Our members added personal donations and our combined total of \$11,000 was returned to our community.

- Beacon Grant-We held our annual Christmas Party honoring the foster and diversion families of Osceola county with Embrace Families of Central Florida. We provided holiday cheer to 200 families and over 430 children with our "Elves on the shelf at the Flks Drive thru"
- 2. Gratitude Grant-We supported Osceola Count of Aging with a very generous donation dedicated to their Pet Program.

3. Spotlight Grant-We are making Welcome Home Kits that will be given to Veterans that have experienced homelessness. We will present a minimum of 10 kits containing new items such as coffee pots, pans, towels, microwaves, cleaning tools, etc. to the VA. As Veterans complete their program and are given housing, these kits will be given to them as most have nothing.

Further support of our community included a check to Wheelchairs for kids for \$1,527.90. We sponsored an Adaptive Tricycle for three year old Joeshlyann that was diagnosed with a rare genetic disorder. She and her family live in Kissimmee.

ENF Gratitude Grant for Kissimmee, FL, Lodge No. 1873

On January 2nd, we received an email.....Congratulations! Your Lodge's 2020-21 Gratitude Grant application has been approved! Your Lodge will receive an approval letter and a grant check in the mail.

On February 3rd several members of the Kissimmee Elks Lodge visited the Osceola Council of Aging and presented the grant check for \$2000 dollars.

Thank you to our Grant Coordinator <u>Lorraine Barker</u> for reaching out to the needs of our Community and completing all of the leg work to make this grant money work for Osceola County!



I would like to begin by thanking the Kissimmee Elks #1873 for their generous donation to the Osceola Council on Aging's (OCOA) Pet Program affording us to purchase food, litter, and some help with veterinary care.

The Program was created to help our Seniors better support and care for their much-loved pets. We had known for some time that many of our Seniors would share their daily delivered, Meals on Wheels (MOW) food with their pets. Unfortunately, often, they would feed their pets before themselves. This obviously defeats the purpose of our mission to feed our Seniors. With that, out of necessity for both our Seniors and their pets, we created a Pet Program where our MOW delivery volunteers also deliver pet food to Senior homes, on a daily basis.

delivery volunteers also deliver pet food to Senior homes, on a daily basis. MOW is the OCOA's flagship program which began 50 years ago. MOW serves

hot home delivered meals daily to our frail senior population in Osceola County. During the past year, the MOW department has naturally expanded nearly four to five times than that of normal capacity, due to the Pandemic, to continue to ensure we do our part to keep seniors' home, fed and safe from the virus. We typically delivered 10,000 meals monthly prior to COVID-19, but since the onset of the virus we have been doing 35,000 to 45,000 monthly deliveries. As one can imagine this has been quite the operation for the OCOA, our MOW department and volunteers.

We are always in need of good, dedicated volunteers for MOW; whether it be to adopt a route and deliver meals and/or pet food to our Seniors. MOW deliveries are Monday through Friday from 8:30 to 10 am. For more information on volunteering for MOW, call 407-847-2144 or email at <u>belislew@osceola-coa.com</u>.
