

Origin of Words from the other Bob....

In George Washington's day there were no cameras. One's image was either sculpted or painted. Some paintings of Gorge Washington showed him standing behind a desk with arm behind his back while others showed both legs and both arms. Prices charged by painters were not based on how many people were to be painted, but by how many limbs were to be painted. Arms and legs are "limbs", there for painting them would cost the buyer more. Hence the expression, "Okay, but it will cost an arm and a leg. (Artists know hands and arms are more difficult to paint)
