### **HOW DOES IT WORK?**

- Youth ages 8-13 advance through local contests (starting with preliminary contests or a Lodge contest), Districts, States, and Regionals to the National Finals in Chicago.
- Six National Champions will have their names and photos displayed at the Naismith Memorial Basketball Hall of Fame in Springfield, Mass.

### LEVELS OF COMPETITION

Youth ages 8-13 are invited to compete in three age groups, 8-9, 10-11, and 12-13, with girls and boys competing separately. Participants can only compete at ONE Lodge contest per year. Then, they must win at each level along the way before stamping a ticket to the National Finals.



At the Lodge Director's discretion, in some communities, the season kicks off with a community-hosted contest. Winners advance to the Lodge contest.
