Terry became a member of the Kissimmee Elks Lodge #1873 on January 28, 2014. Evident financial difficulties plagued our lodge at that time. With the support of the then Exalted Ruler and officers, Terry was tasked with taking over the organizing and accountability of daily transactions. Her background in food service, supervision, inventory and sales aided in the mission. She implemented our current POS, set it up and trained members in its operation. That also allowed the Lodge to be able to easily process credit card payments. This change made it possible for people to call in to renew memberships and order tickets to events, instead of having to come in to physically present their card. This, as well as sever



instead of having to come in to physically present their card. This, as well as several other procedures and practices helped save our Lodge from financial ruin. Her expertise and dedication were quickly recognized with the "2014 Elk of the Year" award.

Eventually she was appointed to the House Committee. She actively served in this position for almost 10 years. In January 2019, our presiding ER abruptly resigned. at the board's request, Terry was installed ER during a meeting on January 28, 2019. In March 2020, as we dealt with Covid-19, Terry was installed for another full term as ER. The installation took place in the parking lot of the lodge with a wagon wheel formation of cars as the officers stood outside with their right hand extended pledging their individual commitment, she received a third and final installation in March 2021. Terry has continued to then work in the House Committee. Terry was very active in setting up and hosting our events. Since Covid the events are a lot smaller, but before those dark days we did have a few events that sold out, particularly NYE and St. Pat's. She took care of the dreaded task of seat assignments. It was also Terry's idea to make Friday's our event nights, which after Covid made a lot of sense.

We thank Terry for all of her dedication and tenure through her various roles at our lodge. As she now retires to spend more quality time with her loved ones. Her great leadership and support to our lodge will log stand.

850 scholarship winners join Elks Family

In April, the Elks National Foundation awarded more than \$3.9 million to high school seniors entering their freshman year of college, welcoming 850 students to the Elks Family. More than just financial aid, an Elks scholarship is an invitation to a network of service-minded peers.

Out of more than 22,000 applicants for the ENF's Most Valuable Student scholarship, the Top 20 scholars received \$30,000 scholarships and an invitation to Chicago for the Most Valuable Student Leadership Weekend. Four-hundred-and-eighty runners-up received \$4,000 scholarships.

From April 11 to 14 in Chicago, the Leadership Weekend offered panels run by current and former Elks scholars to teach the new class about personal branding, transitioning to college, and finding service opportunities through the Elks.

The Elks also welcomed 350 Legacy Awards scholarship recipients to the #ElksFamily. Exclusively for the children or grandchildren of Elks Members, the Legacy Awards are \$4,000 scholarships with a requirement that recipients must serve with a Lodge three times during the four years they receive the scholarship.

1. PLEASE place your order at the "**ORDER AND PAY HERE**" spot or have a seat at the bar.


2. Check your bill before you pay. If something is not right, please tell us so we can correct it or add on that drink that may have been missed. Mistakes will happen.


